1. Purpose

The Deer Park Golf Course is committed to providing accessible and enjoyable golf experiences in a safe, friendly and comfortable setting. Therefore, this policy will establish guidelines for the provision and sale of alcohol at the Deer Park Golf Course.

2. Liquor License

As the owner of Deer Park Golf Course, the City of Yorkton assigns the right to provide alcohol at the golf course to the Food and Beverage Operator, who then is able to obtain a liquor permit from the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Association (SLGA). The Food and Beverage Operator then becomes the registered owner of the liquor license for golf course, and is accountable for all liquor responsibilities required by the SLGA.

3. Policy

Only alcohol purchased through the approved Deer Park Golf Course liquor permit is allowed on golf course property. Any other liquor brought onto the property is prohibited and illegal.

4. General Guidelines

- a. As per the SLGA Regulations, it is illegal for guests to bring their own alcohol onto the course.
- b. Illegal alcohol will be confiscated and may be returned to the customer upon leaving the golf course property.
- c. Staff will not serve anyone to the point of intoxication.
- d. Staff will not serve anyone who appears intoxicated.
- e. Parents, or age of majority escorts, are prohibited from purchasing or sharing alcoholic beverages with underage guests.
- f. In the last one hour of an event, only one (1) standard drink per person will be permitted.
- g. There will be no last call.
- h. Driving impaired is not responsible and is illegal. Golf course staff are instructed to take keys from impaired drivers and provide the option of taking a cab or arranging other means of getting home. If the person refuses to give their keys, and there is reasonable belief that the person will drive the vehicle while intoxicated, the police will be called.
- i. Guests are reminded that a golf cart is a motorized vehicle and that drinking and driving a golf cart is the same as drinking and driving a motor vehicle.
- j. Abuse of staff and guests is not tolerated. Any person who is abusive or disruptive will be asked to leave the golf course property, and if they refuse, the police will be called.

5. Enforcement

- a. The Food and Beverage Operator, along with assistance from the Director of Golf, and their staff shall have the authority to enforce the daily use of this policy.

6. Consequences

- a. It is the responsibility of every guest to be familiar with this policy and comply with the supply, purchase and consumption of alcohol.
- b. Guests are subject to the City of Yorkton Prevention of Verbal & Physical Abuse in Recreation Facilities and Properties Policy.
- c. Failure to observe the guidelines of this policy could result in the confiscation of illegal alcohol, offender required to leave the property, termination of golf privileges, forfeiture of fees and possible criminal charges.

7. Responsibility

The Director of Recreation and Community Services is responsible for the ongoing review and update of this policy.
